- ✓ Sparkling wine based cocktails

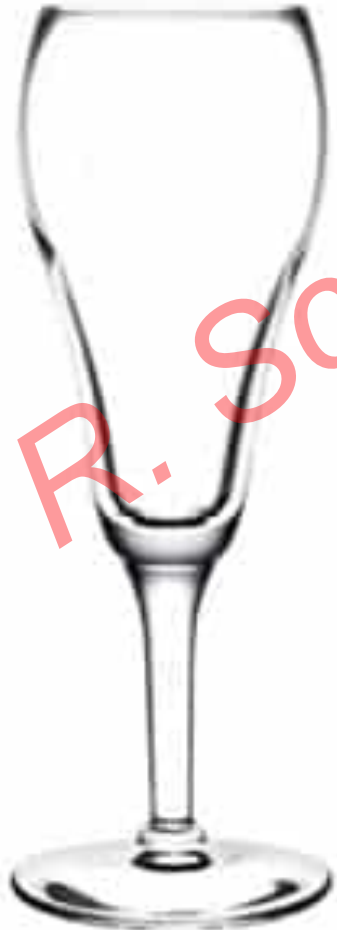


Flute

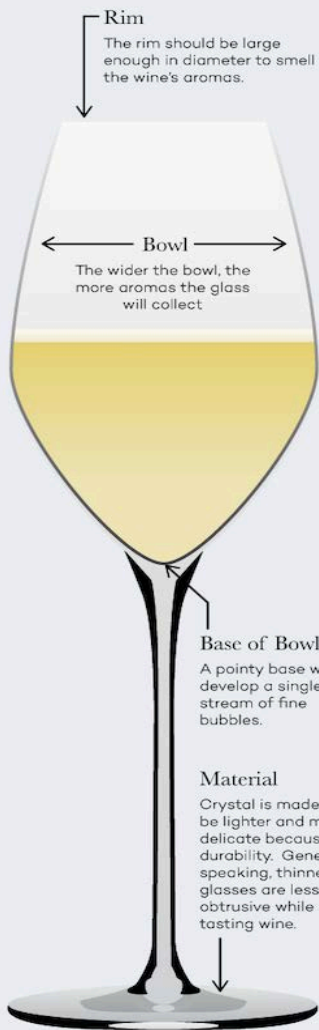
Used for :

Flute

Crémant, Cava, etc

This style of glass preserves the bubbles the most and is ideal for bone-dry (Brut, Extra-Brut and Brut Nature) sparkling wines.



Wide Tulip

Aged Sparkling Wine

This style of glass collects more the aged flavors of biscuit and brioche found in fine sparkling wines such as vintage Champagne, Franciacorta, and Gran Reserva Cava.



Tulip

Prosecco, Rosé, etc

This style of glass collects more floral aromatics with its wider bowl shape and is ideal for more aromatic, fruity sparkling wines.



Coupe Glass

Vintage Design

This design was the popular style used in the 1950s. The bubbles disperse quickly making the wines taste softer and fruitier. This is a fun glass shape to try with sweet sparkling wines such as Asti Spumante.

Highball

Also known as:

- ✓ **Collins glass**

Mainly used for :

- ✓ For spirits with mixers
- ✓ Soft drinks
- ✓ Cocktails



Colada

Also known as:

- ✓ **Hurricane glass**

Mainly used for :

- ✓ Pina Colada but can also be utilised for other long cocktails



Brandy Balloon

Mainly used for brandies such as:

- ✓ Cognac
- ✓ Armagnac
- ✓ Can be used for other liqueurs



Martini Glass

Mainly used for:

- ✓ Dry, Medium and Sweet Martinis
- ✓ Can also be used for Martini based cocktails

Mainly used for:

Mainly used for:

- ✓ Sherry and Port
- ✓ can be used for other fortified wines and still wines



Elgin

Mainly used for:

- ✓ Used primarily for liqueurs
- ✓ Can also be used for sherry in single measures

Mainly used for:

- ✓ Lagers - Bottled or Draught
